Rationale

This inquiry empowers learners to explore the concepts of **injustice**, **inequality**, **and human rights**, both locally and globally. Through critical thinking, role play, and real-world case studies, pupils investigate how inequality affects individuals and communities, and how organisations—including charities and the **United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)**—work to promote fairness and protect rights. The inquiry encourages learners to become **ethical**, **informed citizens** who understand their rights and responsibilities and are motivated to contribute to positive change. It integrates **digital competence** through programming tasks using **J2Code**, and links to **Operation Christmas Child** as a practical way to explore empathy, giving, and global awareness during the festive season.
