


Parent Survey Autumn 2024


1. My child likes this school






2. The school helped my child settle in well when they started.

4. I believe that the school deals with any incidents of bullying, harassment or discrimination well.






5. Explain your answer to question 4.

51 parents responded to this question. 47 responses were positive with answers such as 'issues are always dealt with,' 'any incidents have been brought to our attention promptly,' 'we have not had any issues regarding this, but trust that the school would deal with any issues promptly,' 'the teacher informs you of any such incident and provides updates as required,' we haven't had any experience of this,' 'thankfully my child has never had any issues but should an issue arrive I would like to believe that the school would do everything in their power to address the issue to protect my child and make her feel safe and protected.'

4 responses indicated that they had 'expressed concerns in an email,' and that there were 'instances when situations have not been dealt with,' and that the school 'does not deal well with bullying.'


6. The school offers my child a range of interesting learning experiences, including education trips, visits and extra-curricular activities.






7. My child receives the additional support they need.






8. The school keeps me well informed about my child's progress.






9. The school seeks my views as a parent/carer.






10. The school considers my feedback and, if needed, responds to it.







11. If I share problems or issues with the school, leaders respond and deal with them appropriately.


12. The school shares important information with me in a timely and clear way.






13. I would recommend this school to another parent/carer.
