

'Grab and Go' resources that need to be available to aid outdoor learning

These resources should be stored somewhere where it is easy to access them when you need them. They can be added to as lessons take place

- Washing up bowls/cat litter trays
- Outdoor chalks
- String
- Pipe cleaners
- Double sided tape
- Egg boxes-all sizes
- Yogurt pots/paper cups/collecting pots
- Magnifying glasses
- Paint cards-showing different shades of colours
- Paper plates
- Card
- Paper
- Wooden discs-alphabet-upper case/lower case English and Welsh
- Wooden discs-numbers-number signs dependent on age/stage of the children
- Bubbles
- Gardening gloves/tools
- Digital scales
- Small compasses
- Paint brushes/easels
- Squared acetates-different sizes squares
- Kitchen roll tubes
- Crayons
- Natural materials-either all together OR split e.g. only leaves or shells or sticks or etc
- Woodland animals-foxes, squirrels, owls, badgers etc.
- Laminated leaves from around your own school
- Texture blocks-either bought or made from milk bottle tops/dairy lea tubs
- Treasure hunts-to suit all ages/stages
- Positional language cards-in English and Welsh
- Forces equipment-bean bags hoops different shape and weight boomerangs/discus etc.
- Natural 2d and 3d shapes
